

Setting a culture of strong authority and respect in your classroom

A short Workshop for ECTs and established teachers

All too often we expect students to engage with learning that is important to *us* without ensuring that it's also important to *them*. Many teachers use rewards and punishments in an attempt to persuade children to focus on what they have planned, but become frustrated by the challenging behaviours that nonetheless ensue. In this workshop we explore the link between an engaging curriculum and the positive behaviours we want to see. We look at how we can build our own strong authority and the mutually respectful relationships that are essential for everyone's enjoyment of school.

Key learning will include:

- How to empower children to make good choices about their learning and behaviour
- How a language of authority (rather than authoritarianism) builds better relationships
- How to set your own classroom culture and rules whilst respecting those of the school
- How an engaging curriculum leads to positive behaviours for learning
- How offering trust and choice feeds into a culture of respect and high attainment

Short Workshop Organisation and Costs

90 minute workshops are held remotely (for up to 12 people via Zoom) or face to face at your venue. They are led by former teacher and headteacher Lizzie Overton.

Remote workshops are charged at a rate of £25 per person (with a minimum fee of £150). Face to face workshops cost between £300 (for up to 12 people) and £400 for larger groups. Travel expenses are charged for round trips of more than 40 miles.

Extended Programme and Costs

The extended programme runs remotely (for up to 12 people via Zoom) or face to face at your venue. It is offered either as a series of 5 twilight workshops or 3 afternoon workshops spread over the equivalent of a full term.

The cost of the full programme is £200 per person (with a minimum fee of £750 where less than 4 people are taking part).
